

Saint Ignatius will host two more HSPT Admissions Tests this school year - one on Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup> and the other on Wednesday, November 16<sup>th</sup>. Please be advised that the extended time option and parent information session will be available on Saturday November 5<sup>th</sup> only.

This test is an important step in the admission process for those interested in attending Saint Ignatius High School. While we do accept HSPT scores from tests taken at other high schools, we highly recommend taking the test at least once at Saint Ignatius. You are welcome to take the test more than once, if you would like to, as well. We will only look at the highest score achieved for admissions and scholarship purposes.

Also please be advised that the Financial Aid Application is also due on November 15<sup>th</sup> (in order to be guaranteed to receive your tuition obligation prior to the admissions and decision making process). We will still accept these applications beyond this date, but highly recommend that you submit them as soon as possible in order to have all necessary information heading into the new year. We recommend all those interested apply – about 55% of our families receive need-based tuition assistance, for a total of about \$8 million per year. It doesn't hurt to apply!
